The Accelerated MBA offered at GW's Virginia Campus is designed for students who can commit to an intense academic schedule which is structured, fast paced, and designed to be completed in two years or less. Students progress through the first year as a cohort, completing core requirements as a group while building a strong network of peers. The program is 52.5 credit hours delivered in seven-week modules, with classes held one evening per week and Saturdays.

**LOCATION.** The George Washington University Virginia Campus is located in Loudoun County, inside of the University Center complex in Ashburn, Virginia. The Campus is conveniently located off of Route 7, one mile west of Route 28, five miles north of Dulles International Airport, twelve miles west of Tysons Corner, and eight miles east of historic Leesburg. The campus is linked to Washington, DC via Route 28, the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267), and Interstate 66. Parking is free.



**INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS.** The GW Virginia Campus offers innovative programs for experienced professionals seeking advanced degrees without career interruption. Graduate education is provided in key focus areas of business and management leadership, education, information systems management and technology, telecommunications, engineering and transportation safety, and health sciences.
